The role will predominantly focus on hands on coaching of the SBHS 1st XI in the Premier Club Competition and across Interschool matches.

- Accredited Coach ideally to a NZC Development Coach (Level 1) or international equivalent (or working towards the achievement of this qualification), or high performance playing experience
- Currently an active high-level player
- Current driver licence
- Must be legally entitled to work in NZ
- Past involvement with high performing cricketers in early and late teenage years, including coaching at talent level
- Experience of the domestic game and knowledge of the requirements to be successful at this level as a player and coach
- Knowledge and commitment to aligning secondary school cricket to the needs of Southland Cricket talent programmes
