



DULUX BOUNDARY RIDERS TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The promotion is offered by NZC of Level 4, 8 Nugent St, Grafton, Auckland 1023 New Zealand.
2. The competition is open to all children between the ages of 10 to 14 years.
3. All entrants must have received consent from a parent or guardian.
4. All entrants must complete the online entry which must contain name, address, date of birth, contact details & preferred match.
5. The draw will take place two weeks prior to the specific match day. The winners will be notified by phone and a follow up email 2 weeks prior to the game of their preference. If any winner cannot be contacted or does not respond within one day of being notified that they have won, that draw will be declared null and void at NZC's discretion and another winner will be drawn.
6. The winner (plus a friend & 1 adult) will need to make their way to the game venue at their own expense.
7. The terms of the participant will include the winner to complete a consent form by the parent/guardian.
8. NZC will collect and hold personal information provided by the entrants for notifying the winners, to verify identities and it may be used for subsequent promotional activities.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- NZC will carry out pre-match and post-match meetings with the winners to ensure that they have an opportunity to ask any questions they may have. This will include (but not limited to) a reminder on the potential dangers associated with ball strike, that each boundary rider must keep their eye on the ball once the ball has been bowled and to be aware of what can happen to the ball once it hits the boundary rope.
- NZC will make public service announcements throughout the day to 'Keep your eye on the ball', these are made through the Ground Announcer and shown on the big screen.
- Each child will be provided with a stool/seat which will allow him/her to sit down behind the LED boards (1.2 metres in height).
- Each child will spend approximately 30- 40 minutes (10 overs) carrying out their role as a boundary rider, then will be replaced and be able to have a break.
- Each child will be provided with water, sunblock, and a sun hat.
- NZC will have a Health and Safety Co-Ordinator based at the boundary edge and checking in on the children at each station throughout the day.
